### CURRENT REQUIREMENTS FOR “COMMUNITY CARE” ASSISTANCE 2022

ASSISTANCE ONLY OFFERED IN OCEAN, MONMOUTH, AND ATLANTIC COUNTY’S AT THIS TIME

- Homeowner must have owned and occupied the home their living in for at least the past 36 months to request assistance
- The home must serve as the homeowner's primary residence
- The home must have a professional contractor quote of at least \$10,000 for assistance to qualify (JSU will not repair space considered the Garage, Crawl Space or Basement. Only primary living space will qualify)
- Homeowners' residence must be a single story, single-family home under 1500 square feet
- Homeowners must qualify using the New Jersey LMI chart as a low income family based on your household adjusted gross annual income at the time you submit the application. Adherence to income limits is required for eligibility for the duration of the program (See Chart)
- Jersey Shore United will only offer assistance when the homeowner has exhausted all other options for assistance and funding
- Jersey Shore United will consider offering volunteer assistance when funding for the materials is available through the homeowner. This will be on a case-by-case basis
